Celebrating 30 Years of AFP Calgary & Area Chapter

This fall marked a significant milestone for AFP Calgary & Area Chapter—the 30th anniversary of our formation. In late 1993, a dedicated group of Calgary fundraisers came together to establish the Canadian Society of Fundraising Executives (CSFRE), allowing Calgary to host the Certified Fundraising Executive (CFRE) examination at local proctored

sites. Shortly after, the chapter was officially registered as a non-profit organization, operating under the name National Society of Fundraising Professionals (NSFRE) and aligning with the largest network of fundraising professionals in the world. In 2003, our parent organization rebranded as the Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP), growing into a global network with 240 chapters worldwide.

Today, AFP Calgary & Area is one of the largest and



most active of the 20 chapters in Canada. This year marks the 28th annual National Philanthropy Day and 30 years of offering professional development, advocacy and networking opportunities for non-profit sector professionals.

To commemorate this milestone, we launched the **Legacy of Spirit Campaign**, aimed at raising funds to support scholarships for professional development. By partnering with the **AFP Foundation for Philanthropy Canada**, we created a unique opportunity for donors to contribute directly to the growth and education of fundraising professionals in our community.

Other Key Milestones in Our 30th Anniversary Year:

- Introduction of a new Generosity of Spirit Award Community Catalyst Award
- **Illuminating the Calgary Tower** in AFP brand colours on November 15, 2024, in recognition of National Philanthropy Day
- **Media Partnership with CORUS Entertainment** to amplify our message of philanthropy and community impact
